Dnipro, Ukraine
September 24th - 27th, 2020

Ukraine will host the 2020 FISU World University Waterski & Wakeboard Championships in Dnipro city, from September 24th to 27th, 2020.

Organiser

Venue

The 2020 FISU World University Waterski & Wakeboard Championships will take place at Dnipro River, Dnipro city, Ukraine, which is a world-class facility specifically built for waterskiing and wakeboarding. Dnipro hosted the IWWF World Under 21 Championships in 2017, the IWWF Cableski World Championships in 2018, the IWWF Europe & Africa Youth Championships, the IWWF European Open and Age categories Championships in 2016, All Ukrainian National competitions since 2007.

Dnipro is Ukraine's fourth largest city. It is 391 kilometers (243 mi) southeast of the capital Kyiv on the Dnieper River, in the south-central part of the country. the city is the administrative center of the Dnipropetrovsk Oblast





Temperature in Dnipro City

The average temperature in September is 15.6°C, high 21.5°C and low 10.7°C.

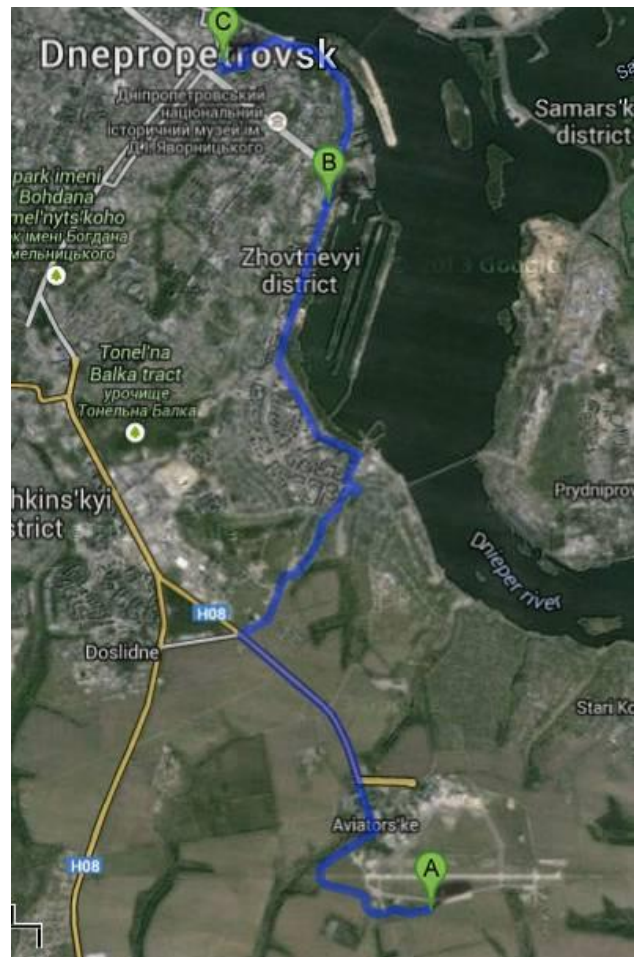
1. Airport

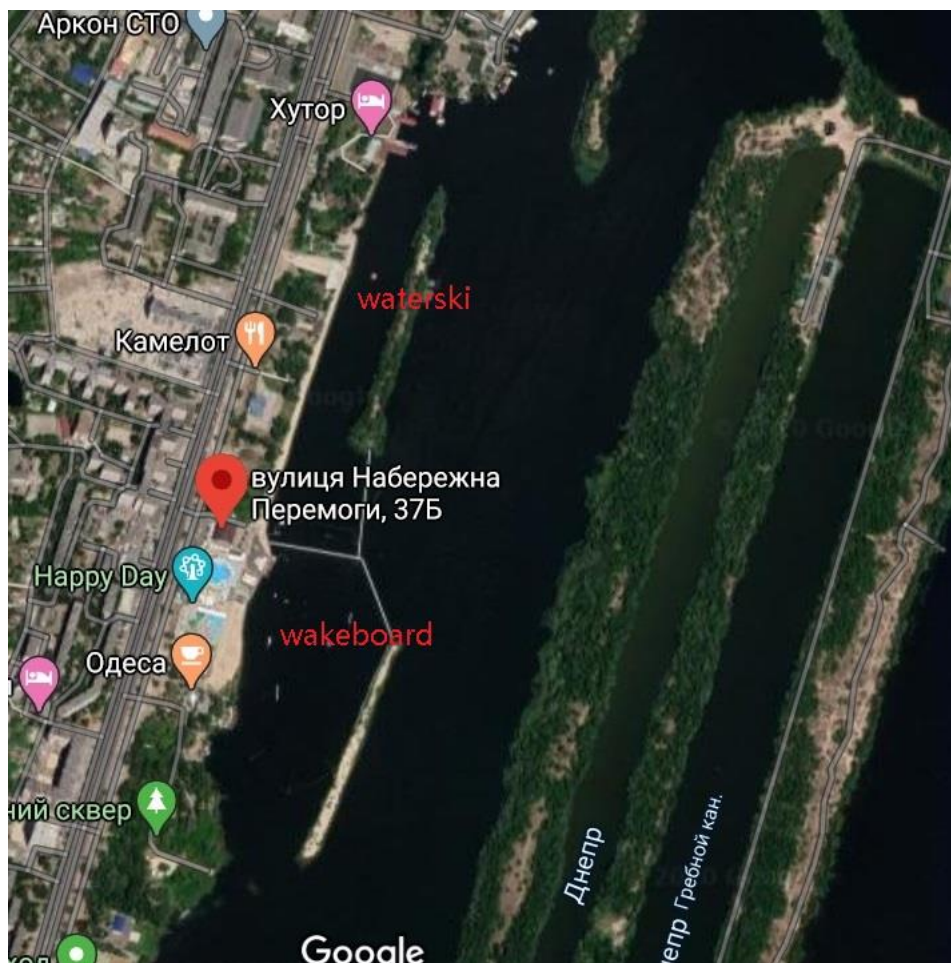
The closest and the only airport is Dnipro International Airport (DNK). Regular direct flights are available from Vienna, Tel-Aviv and Kyiv. Distance between the airport (A) and the Hotel “Menorah” and “7 days” (C) is 18 kilometers with the Venue of competition (B) in between.

Hotel “Dnipro” is near the point C, while hotel “Hutor” is close to the Point B.

The red drop is “Sentosa Cable Park”– there is an office, showers, toilets, catering tent, etc.

Waterski stadium is on the left hand and the wakeboard stadium on the right hand (near Sentosa Cable Park)

Transportation

After arriving to Dnipro airport, the Organiser will provide transportation for participants to Hotel in the center of the city and for ski equipment to the ski site directly. Shuttle will first stop at ski storage and only then will take you to your hotel. We suggest skiers to remove their personal belongings/ clothing from ski bags.

The organiser will provide transportation to and from the venue and the hotel during the tournament days. Schedule to be announced in Bulletin2.

Accommodation

2. The second alternative hotel is the 3* hotel Dnipro <http://dnipro-hotel.dp.ua/> (the renovated rooms only). The distance between the “Menorah center” and the “Dnipro” hotel is 5 min walk. There is a bus stop next to Dnipro Hotel. There will be a trolley shuttle for all the participants in the morning, in the evening and during the day. The schedule will be provided in Bulletin 2.

Catering

Breakfast will be provided at the hotels for teams and officials during the days of the event. Lunches will be provided at the competition venue. Details on dinners will be published in Bulletin 2.

Rules - General

The competition will be conducted according to the [IWWF](#) World Waterski Rules for slalom, tricks, jump and wakeboard, and will be managed under FISU regulations.

Only athletes who satisfy the following conditions may take part in a FISU World University Championship:

- Must be a national of the country they represent
- Must be at least 18 years old and no older than 25 years of age on the 31st December of the year of the event; for 2020, athletes must be born between the 01/01/1995 and the 31/12/2002.
- Have to be students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country;
- Have to be former students of the institutions mentioned in In the first point who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event;

Each country may enter a maximum of 6 skiers with no more than 4 skiers per gender for waterski and 4 riders with no more than 2 riders per gender for wakeboard. Delegations can be as large as 13 people. If you have a full team of 10 athletes, you can have up to 3 officials. Any additional other officials will be considered as extra officials.

FISU Registration Fees

FISU shall receive from each competing country the following FISU registration fees:

- member-associations of FISU: 20 euros (€) per participant
- non-member associations: 40 euros (€) per participant

These fees will be invoiced to the participating delegations by FISU.

Participation Fees to the Organising Committee (full board and event services):

- a participation fee of 70 euros (€) per person per night
- extra officials will pay a participation fee of 140 euros (€) per person per night

The Organizing Committee will provide you with an invoice at your request for the payment of the participation fees or the fees may be paid by bank transfer to the bank account

Official Familiarization

The last two or three days immediately before the Championships will be reserved and used for Official Familiarization. This will be organized so that each competitor who has

paid shall be allocated either a set number of passes and/or a certain amount of time at the discretion of the Chief Judge based on the principle that every skier shall receive an equal opportunity for familiarization.

- Slalom skiers will receive – 4 passes or 6 minutes whichever is less
- Tricks skiers will receive – 2 passes or 5 minutes whichever is less
- Jump skier will receive – 3 passes or 6 minutes whichever is less

Each team requesting familiarization time shall write to the Organising Committee. Familiarization is required at least 60 days before the start of the event. They must indicate how many skiers in each event wish to participate. Teams who do not comply with this deadline will not be included in the familiarization schedule. At least 45 days before the start of the event, the Organizer (in consultation with the Chief Judge, whose decision shall be final) shall announce the official familiarization schedule (including the allowed time). The order for familiarization will be based on the team results from the previous World Championships with the last placed team athletes going first, and shall be grouped by event, i.e. slalom familiarization, trick familiarization and jump familiarization (by jump height) will be grouped together. Any athlete whose time has not been paid for at least 30 days before the scheduled start of the event, or who is not ready to ski in accordance with the schedule, will lose their official familiarization time.

Summary Table:

- 60 days before - deadline for familiarization requests – 24th July 2020
- 45 days before - deadline for publishing familiarization schedule by Organizer – 9th August 2020
- 30 days before - deadline for familiarization payment – 24th August 2020

The Chief Judge shall have the discretion to change the start time of team's familiarization based on extraordinary circumstances.

The cost of the Official Familiarization is 240 EUR/per hour (4 EUR/per minute)

Unofficial Training

This will be available any time before the official start of the Championships. The training cost will be 240 EUR/per hour. Minimum slot to book is 15 minutes. Any team or athlete who wants to train before the Official Familiarization should send the request to office@2020wucwaterski-wakeboard.com. Below is a picture for waterski stadium. The drop on water is the ramp.

Your training will be confirmed once you receive a confirmation letter with an invoice to be paid within 10 days by bank transfer.

Entry Procedure

National University teams must submit their Intent to Enter no later than 24 March 2020 (6 months before the event).

Note: Intentions to Enter and Entries MUST be submitted exclusively through the online FISU entry system <https://accreditation.fisu.net/WUC-WS-05/Pages/Home.aspx>

- Quantitative Entry

National University teams must submit their quantitative entry (amount of female, male athletes, coaches and other team members) no later than 24 June 2020 (3 months prior to the event).

- Official Entry

National University teams must submit their official entries for Championships no later than 24 August 2020 (1 month prior to the event).

In accordance with FISU regulations, a reasonable number of athletes shall be tested in all sports in which it is required by regulations of the appropriate International Sports Federation. Out-of-Competition as well as Target Testing may be applied to athletes participating at any time during the Event period. By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control.
